15th Anniversary of the Canberra Bushfires

Mid January marked 15 years since the devastating 2003 Canberra bushfires that destroyed the old Cotter Centre at Greenhills. Below is an excerpt from the book 'Life + Faith' by Robyn Hipkiss that outlines an account of these events from the perspective of Paula, one of the managers at the time.

"January 18 was a sweltering hot Saturday with scorching winds battering the bush and stirring the dust, which lodged like grit in our eyes as we went about our work... When I looked up I saw the fire had converged with one from the other direction and a wall of fire was roaring over the hill toward Greenhills at a great speed. It was a terrifying sight and the noise was horrendous. I only had minutes to make my escape. There was no time to gather up photos or precious possessions. As I ran from the house I simply cried out in all sincerity, "Jesus, this is your house and all that is in it is yours. You can have it if you want, but I'm asking you to look after it for us..." The next hour-and-a-half would forever change the face of Greenhills as we knew it. The fire came up the valley and over the hill and raged over us..."



We sat pressed up against the back wall, swaddled in wet towels and breathing through wet tea-towels. The noise was deafening, as if hundreds of trains were roaring overhead. Our hearts were pounding as we prayed and asked God for His protection over us and the entire complex... When the worst of the fire storm had passed over us, the air in the auditorium had become so contaminated with smoke and debris we couldn't stay there any longer... Incredibly, the building was intact. The body of the fire had roared up the valley then, miraculously, jumped right over the top of the whole Murrumbidgee Centre, including the accommodation blocks on the hill beside us... Suddenly the vacuum created by the intensity of the fire as it passed over us seemed to suck the flames back and ignite a second wave of burning. It was as if the fire came back to finish the job it had started. We stood in shock and watched as the old original Cotter Centre down the hill below us caught fire and lit up the sky. Dorms and halls were consumed by flames ignited by the intense heat from the sparks and embers. The buildings were flattened by exploding gas bottles... Over the following days, weeks and months we were encouraged, inspired and humbled by the generosity, love and support of so many people... Every day I thank God for His protection and abundant provision. I will never forget the assurance of His presence with us during our time at Greenhills, and especially on the day of the fire."
